An informational page must be submitted that contains the following information:

- Current Year
- Name
- If it is your first time submitting a record book
- Years in 4-H
- Clubs
- Club Offices Held / Leadership Roles
- Projects Taken / Demonstration & Project Talk

4-H Records

Members will be able to select the format in which they would like to submit their annual 4-H records. Below are the options available.

 - Project Story
 1. Select 1 or more 4-H Projects you have enrolled in.
 2. Choose 1 method you wish to tell your project Story. Feel free to be creative! Some methods or ideas you may wish to do include:
 - Written story: narrative and/or outline
 - Photo story: series of photographs with captions – Fair Entry
 - Resume
 - 4-H Portfolio
 - Mind Map
 - Presentation (ex: Powerpoint, Google, etc.)
 - Video
 - CANSKI Training Log
 - Other format with Approval of 4-H Agent. Other acceptable could be a webpage, blog, podcast, etc.
 3. Expand on your project(s) by telling your Project Story in the method selected. Include some or all of the following information in your Project Story:
 - Describe/illustrate what you learned in this project.
 - Describe/illustrate the process you used to make your item(s), care for and train your animal(s) and so on.
 - Describe/illustrate the skills you gained and practiced.
 - List your goals and describe/illustrate your progress toward your goals.
 - Describe/illustrate your leadership experiences in this project, if appropriate.
 - Parent comments may be included, but they are optional.
 - Financial records associated with your project.
- Options of what can be included:
- Newspaper clippings, pictures from magazines and/or catalogs, computer graphics.
 - Original drawings and/or other original artwork.
 - Programs from club, county and/or other 4-H events.
 - Samples of fabric, yarn and so on.
 - Please do not include any actual awards (ribbons, plaques, trophies and so on) from any competitive event. Pictures or other graphic representations of awards are acceptable.
