CLEANSWEEP WILL ACCEPT

- Oil and lead based paints
- Aerosol spray paints
- Lubricants
- Solvents
- Pesticides and fertilizers
- Household and hazardous cleaners
- Corrosives
- Flammables
- Lead tackle and shot
- Old gas, antifreeze, and other chemicals you wouldn't consider dumping
- Mercury containing thermostats, switches, and thermometers

CLEANSWEEP WILL NOT ACCEPT

- Latex paint
- Empty paint cans
- Oil filters
- Motor oil
- Explosives, flares or fireworks
- Freon 11 & 12
- Radioactive materials (including smoke/Co2 alarms)
- Ammunition
- Compressed gas cylinders-any size
- Recyclables
- Appliances
- Asbestos
- Biological or infectious wastes
- Sharps or EpiPens
- Spray foam cylinders
- Incandescent light bulbs
- PFAS containing items
