Timeline

- ➤ Applicants must have materials submitted to the Extension Office by the following due date: Friday, March 10th, 2023 at 4PM
- Scholarship recipient(s) and the dollar amounts are approved by the Leaders Association by the March meeting. There will be 4 scholarships of \$500 each.
- > Scholarship recipients will be announced near the end of March during Awards Night.
- > Senior(s) will receive their scholarship funds as soon as the applicant submits evidence of being enrolled for the first semester of their continuing education institution.

Qualifications & Instructions

Senior Scholarships are based on the following:

- o Applicant must be a high school senior <u>currently enrolled</u> in the Ashland County 4-H youth program.
- o Be an active member in good standing for no less than three (3) years.
- o Complete application and <u>list activities on a separate page.</u>
- Show motivation by writing typed & double-spaced essays for these 4 questions (up to 500 words each):
 - 1. Please describe a specific experience you had in 4-H where you had to problem solve and/or work with a team. What was the result? How did that experience help you become more mindful and grow as a person?
 - 2. Please describe a specific experience where you befriended and/or supported a fellow 4-H member. Why did you reach out to this person? What was their reaction? What did you learn from that experience?
 - 3. Please describe a 4-H event or activity in which you participated that you feel met our commitment to larger service. What did you do? What new things did you learn at that event or activity? What new things did you learn about yourself?
 - **4.** Please describe a 4-H experience or activity that you think improved your physical, mental, or emotional health. How did this help you grow and how can this help your friends and family?
- o Provide the names of two (2) non-related adults qualified to evaluate the achievement and character of the applicant. Send them each a reference form (page 3 & 4) to be submitted to Kate Wallner by the due date.
