<b>Adult Advisors (Chaperones)</b> <a href="#">(full info here)</a>	Work with a team of adult advisors and PYD staff to ensure youth have a safe and positive educational experience	Varies on each event & preparation, usually ranges between 1-5 days in the year per event	<input type="checkbox"/> Event-Specific Application <input type="checkbox"/> Youth Protection Process (online) <input type="checkbox"/> Enrolled in 4-H as volunteer leader <input type="checkbox"/> Over 21 years old (sometimes 25+)
<b>Club Enrollment Coordinators</b> <a href="#">(full info here)</a>	Provide leadership for members and adult volunteers who are enrolling in the club or group organization	1 year commitment, ranges between 1-4 hours per month	<input type="checkbox"/> Online training (2) <input type="checkbox"/> VIP training with local educator
<b>Club Leaders (5 different kinds)</b> <a href="#">(full info here)</a>	Provide leadership to the club or group organization of youth & assisting adults	Minimum of 1 year commitment, ranges between 4-10 hours a month	<input type="checkbox"/> Online training (2) <input type="checkbox"/> VIP training with local educator
<b>Committee Volunteers</b> <a href="#">(full info here)</a>	Participate as a member of a committee, creating educational experiences for all youth engaged in the program	Varies on each committee but is seasonal/short term, usually ranges between 2-15 hours a season	<input type="checkbox"/> Online training (2) <input type="checkbox"/> VIP training with local educator <input type="checkbox"/> Potential workshops
<b>Project Leaders (3 different kinds)</b> <a href="#">(full info here)</a>	Provide leadership and organization to the project group learning about a specific topic	Varies and flexible based on each project, usually ranges between 2-10 hours per week, month, or quarter	<input type="checkbox"/> Online training (2) <input type="checkbox"/> VIP training with local educator <input type="checkbox"/> Potential project-specific workshops
