4-H Spring Art Contest

Opens on March 20, Closes on April 28
Art materials available at Ash-Co 4-H Office

Based on the different suggestions shared at last year's Spring Gala, this year's theme is Mixed-Media with the added requirement of featuring an animal in the artwork entry. The age ranges are the same (5-6, 7-8, and so on). The contest opens March 20 (the office has canvases and various multi media materials like felt, glue, mod podge, paints, and other items for families to use). An optional Art Tutorial is Saturday March 29th from 1-3pm (see more info below). Artwork is due by Monday April 28 at 6:30pm (Kate will stay in the office late so folks ending work can still stop in to drop off canvases). Kate will also be in the office until 6:30pm on March 20 when the contest opens, as well as each Monday before the Spring Gala so that anyone needing the extra time to grab art supplies may do so. So excited to see all the masterpieces! Oh, and local 4-H adults can share their entries, too (not for judging but for fun)!

Art Contest Tutorial

Saturday, March 29 from 1-3pm
Ashland County 4-H Office (1st Floor of Courthouse)

Come practice mixed-media and experiment with different art materials you are curious about using! Pick-up art supplies to bring back home for completing your work of art to enter in the contest.

art materials provided

2025 4-H SPRING ART CONTEST INFORMATION GUIDE

2025 Contest Theme = Mixed-Media

2025 Contest Topic = Animal Kingdom

Mixed-media is a visual art style that includes multiple types of materials like paint, cloth, paper, wood, pens, crayons, etc. Contest entries must have at least 3 different kinds of material in their mixed-media artwork, and it must feature at least one animal. The artist can choose how many and what type of animals.

ART CONTEST TIMELINE & REQUIREMENTS

The Spring Art Contest officially opens on Thursday, March 20, 2025.

- Canvases and art supplies can be picked up at the Ash-Co 4-H office 8am-4pm.
- Artists are welcome to use their own materials or ask the office for more materials.
- Extended office hours will be kept on Mondays until 6:30pm for art pick-up.

The Contest closes on Monday, April 28 so local artists can review all the entries.

- Artwork entries are due by 6:30pm to the Ash-Co 4-H office on the closing date.
- Remember to give your artwork a title on the back of the canvas (see info below)!
- Artwork is reviewed based Creativity, Craftsmanship, & Comprehension.

Entries are displayed and awards announced at the Spring Gala - Sunday, May 4, 2025!

- Detailed invites will be online and mailed to 4-H Online registered families.
- Optional activities are offered before and after awards are announced.
- All artwork entries are displayed, and participants receive certificates and/or prizes.

Please keep in mind that each artwork...

- Needs to be an original work made by the youth participant
- Can be displayed on the 1st Floor of the Ash-Co Courthouse after the Spring Gala
- Can later be submitted to the Ashland County Junior Fair Exhibit in August

Artwork is reviewed and awarded within age categories (7 Total)

- ages 5-6
- ages 7-8
- ages 9-10
- ages 11-12
- ages 13-14
- ages 15-16
- ages 17-19
